



Home Cleaning Tips

- Label and store cleaning supplies by the task for which they are used.
 - Bathroom cleaners: toilet cleaner with designated brush; sink, tub, and counter cleaner with designated sponge; mirror cleaner and paper towels
 - Kitchen cleaners: hand soap, dish detergent for hand-washed dishes and pots, dishwasher detergent for the machine, sponges and scrubbies, disinfectant/antimicrobial for countertops, stovetop degreaser/cleaner, paper towels
 - Floors: broom with dustpan, mini-vacuum, mop and bucket with disinfectant cleaner, Swiffer-type mop with pads, hardwood cleaner
 - Carpets: vacuum cleaner, carpet freshener
 - Furniture: duster, dust cloth with furniture polish, Swiffer-type duster
 - Windows or glass-tops: glass cleaner, lint-free cloth or paper towels
 - Refrigerator: baking soda in refrigerator and freezer compartments

Keep cleaners out of reach of persons who are not able to understand the purpose of the products.
